Councilmember McClellan asks questions concerning the process for vehicle purchases, the declaration statements to be signed by purchasing parties, and applicability of the half of one-percent (0.50) sales tax.

Residents living outside the City of El Cajon will not be required to pay the extra sales tax. If an overpayment has occurred, the purchaser would receive a refund of the overpayment.
